## "Daily Bread"

<sup>5</sup> "And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. <sup>6</sup> But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. <sup>7</sup> And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. <sup>8</sup> "Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. <sup>9</sup> In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. <sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.

### **<sup>11</sup> Give us this day our daily bread.**

<sup>12</sup> And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. <sup>13</sup> And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

<sup>14</sup> "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. <sup>15</sup> But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. —Matthew 6: 5-15 (NKJV)

In the KINGDOM of HEAVEN..." **How matters!"**

(The Lord's Prayer is a prayer of a righteous person pursuing the heart of the Father in Heaven.)

### **Verse 11 marks a shift in the Lord's prayer.**

From the majesty and hallowedness of God to impartation and the desire to experience His goodness and outpouring over us.

- Give us
- Forgive us
- Lead us
- Deliver us.

Verse 11 – "**Give us this day our daily bread**" means...

**SURRENDERED \_\_\_\_\_ (on the Lord to provide all of my needs.)**

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. —Philippians 4: 19

(Never allow yourself to settle for the taste of the enemy's kitchen over the supply of the Lord's table)

<sup>4</sup>Then the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, **that I may test them**, whether they will walk in My law or not. <sup>5</sup>And it shall be on the sixth day that they shall prepare what they bring in, and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily." —Exodus 16: 4-5
